UGA Support Funds

Emergency Support Funds are available to assist currently enrolled UGA students by providing financial support when they need assistance with unexpected, unforeseen, and unavoidable emergency expenses. Funding is limited and awarded amounts will vary as it depends on students' individual financial need. The fund is intended to address specific temporary circumstances students may be facing such as:

- Medical bills
- Replacement of essential personal belonging due to natural disaster, fire, theft, etc.
- Car repairs
- Personal safety needs (e.g. changing a lock)
- Medications or other health-related costs
- Mental health care
- Rent, utilities, or other essential household expenses

Process
